Injured player refund policy

Players suffering a serious injury or health problems preventing him or her from *playing and practicing*

Each season consists of:

6 months from late September to the end of March for a total of 26 weeks. A player is entitled to a partial refund if he is unable to play and practice for 10 consecutive weeks or more during the hockey season due to his injury or illness.

Cost of registration minus overhead of $120 = \cos t$ of ice & program 380 - 120 = 260

The cost of registration is the cost of the program set at the beginning of the registration process and does not factor in late penalties or additional fees.

In a family package of 3 or more children, the cost of registration for the injured player would be calculated based on the amount remaining after full registration has been paid for the players continuing play. 1350 – player one registration – player two registration

= amount of registration for injured player - \$120 = /26 weeks x weeks injured
